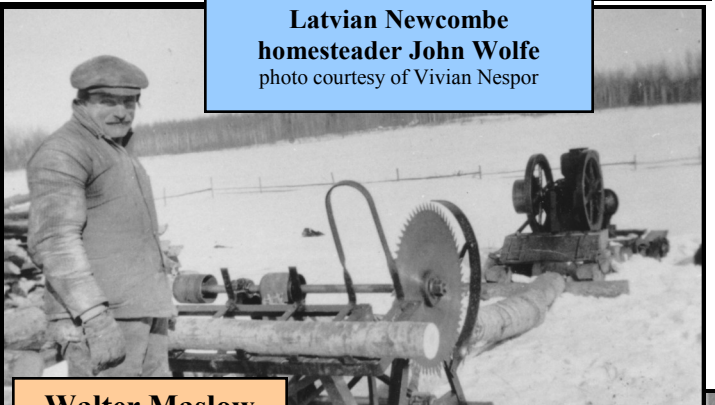

Have a vintage item you are not sure what it is? Bring it in during our Heritage Day for identification

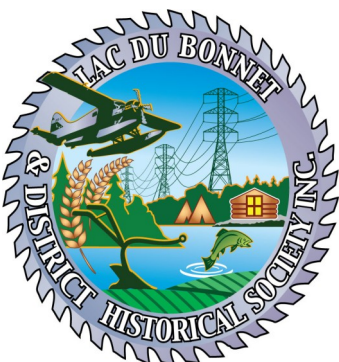
